Terms & Conditions

- 1) Entry forms must reach us by Wednesday 12th March. Please advise us by phone if you are running late so that we can expect the form. Payment of entry fees is to be made before the Exhibition. We prefer entry forms by email, or post, rather than by photos from your phone. Forms can be downloaded from our website www.penshurstartexhibition.org.au and posted or emailed to info@penshurstcreativearts.org.au or contact Tom Cooke 0488 557 345 for postal entry forms.
- 2) By submitting your Entry Form by post or via email, you enter into an agreement with Penshurst Creative Arts Inc and you agree to comply with these Terms and Conditions.
- 1) <u>Art Works for hanging will be accepted</u> at the Penshurst Memorial Hall, 21 Martin Street, on Friday 15th & Saturday 16th March, 2024, 10.00am 4.00pm. Please phone or text when you are coming to Penshurst. Tom 0488 557 345 and Ama 0402 870 738. We will accept the art works at other times by arrangement.
- 3) There is <u>no limit</u> to the number of original uncopied works each artist can submit for displaying provided fees are paid (see below). Only original artwork will be judged. Prints can be for sale at the Exhibition.
- 4) Dimensions of works will not exceed: a) Height: 150 cm (or 100 cm if width is up to 150 cm) b) Width: 100 cm (or 150 cm if height is up to 100 cm) c) Thickness: 7.5 cm Unframed canvases are acceptable as long as they have provision for hanging them. Miniature section no larger than A4 framed.
- 5) Fees are as follows:
 - a) A fee of \$10 for each art works up to and including 1m x 1m.
 - b) A fee of \$15 for all those over $1m \times 1m$, up to $1m \times 1.5$ metre (one of these large paintings count as two of the smaller size).
 - c) Pairs (diptych) or trios (triptych) will be accepted as one entry for one entry fee. However, the total square area of both or all three works must fall within the size limits.
 - d) A fee of \$6 applies to each Miniature. Size is set at A4 framed. Limit of 4.
 - d) <u>Primary School Children's entries in children's section \$2.00 each</u>. Under the general section see a & b of this section.
 - e) Youth entries fee of \$5.00 per entry. Youth age 13 17 years.
- 6) All Paintings <u>can</u> be available for sale. Commission to PCAi is 15%. Prices should be clearly marked on both the back of the painting on the information panel provided below, and on the paperwork that the artist has filled in. When in doubt management will always use the price on the entry form.
- 7) All paintings must have suitable provision for hanging.
- 8) It is advised that you have insurance on your artwork. We will not be responsible for damage or theft.
- 9) The judging committee has the right to Not accept all paintings entered and any works not selected will not be displayed.
- * NOT ACCEPTABLE FOR ENTRY ARE:
- a) Non-original work (i.e. copying another painting or reproduction).

- b) Paintings with inadequate means of hanging,
- c) damaged on arrival (damaged art works will be photographed once unwrapped),
- d) inappropriate artwork (as so judged by the selection panel),
- e) not complying with work as per entry form.
- f) entries that have been in our Exhibition in previous years.
- 10) We encourage you to attach an artist's statement (up to 100 words) at the time of entry.
- 11) There will be a catalogue this year.
- 12) The judges' decision is final.
