

Welcome to the first newsletter of the Penshurst Mens Shed Inc. There are many people the Committee would like to thank for their help in forming the outline that has become our Association. Nigel Pyne was the instigator who, through discussions with Terry Horsten, Melanie Russell and Jane Coshutt of Southern Grampians Shire Council, John Brennan from the Penshurst Post Office, Paul Sutherland and Marcus Rentsch from Advance Penshurst, Laurie Jarmon, Beth Howlett, Andrew Rentsch from the Apex Shed, that has become our base of operations, and other men and women who have offered to help and attended those first community meetings, until the Inaugural Meeting in January 2018 when the Penshurst Mens Shed Incorporated Association was launched. We would also like to thank the Victorian Mens Shed Association for their help and generous donation of tools from different Sheds around Victoria when we became a member Club.

Since we opened to the public we have received one grant from the SGSC to upgrade our amenities to disability standard, one grant for tools from South West Community Foundation, and have put in a grant application to the State Government to extend our workshop and upgrade the social side of the building, which will be helped by another grant, in waiting, from SGSC. We have received other donations of tools, work benches, and our table tennis table.

Recently we were delighted to receive a \$100 donation from St Joseph's School which we have applied to the refurbishing of the bench in the garden at the Kolor Lodge. We will be refurbishing the outside play area at the Kindergarten, which includes making some larger-than-life coloured pencils. We are also helping people around town



with small projects such as fixing fences. Future activities include taking the Men's Shed mobile and visiting with men at the Kolor Lodge for various woodworking projects. There is also work lined up in Hamilton.

The Men's Shed is open to women too, particularly on Tuesday afternoons when we meet for our Social.





The following recipe of mine was a great hit with everyone at our church at one of our dinners.

TUSCAN MEATBALLS (SERVES 4)

Ingredients

Mince Beef 500g
Eggs x 2
Condensed tomato soup 425g
Garlic Salt 1/2 x tbsp
Masterfoods Tuscan seasoning 1/2 x tbsp
Dried Oregano Leaves x Qty
Breadcrumbs
Olive oil
Mozzarella Cheese (shredded)

Method

In a large bowl mix meat and eggs,

Add garlic salt and Tuscan seasoning and mix well.

Add two or three hand fulls of the shredded cheese and mix well.

Add breadcrumbs until mixture thickens enough to craft balls.

Form meatballs of a generous size.

Lightly oil base of slow cooker or oven proof dish.

Place meatballs in a slow cooker ideally or in an oven proof dish.

Cover meatballs with tomato soup and sprinkle with oregano leaves to taste.

Add salt and pepper to taste.

Cook in slow cooker on Low for six hours or low heat in oven.

Keep warm to serve with salad and crusty bread
